1987 Wisconsin Act 180

AN ACT to create 48.396 (7) of the statutes, relating to school district notification of child delinquency adjudications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 48.396 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

48.396 (7) Notwithstanding sub. (2), if a child is adjudged delinquent, the court clerk shall notify the school board of the school district in which the child is enrolled of the fact that the child has been adjudicated delinquent unless the child's parent requests, in writ-

ing, that the information not be provided. No other information from the child's court records may be disclosed to the school board except by order of the court. Any information provided to the school board under this subsection may be disclosed by the school board only to employes of the school district who have been determined by the school board to have legitimate educational interests in the information.
