1987 Wisconsin Act 237

AN ACT to amend 60.22 (4); and to create 165.85 (4m) of the statutes, relating to training for constables.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 60.22 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

60.22 (4) JURISDICTION OF CONSTABLE. Shall determine the jurisdiction and duties of the town constable. The town board may also require the town constable to complete training under s. 165.85 (4m).

SECTION 2. 165.85 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:

165.85 (4m) TRAINING FOR CONSTABLES. The board shall establish a separate training program for those constables who are not required to complete training under sub. (4). Except as provided in s. 60.22 (4), a constable may voluntarily participate in the program under this subsection. Expenses incurred for this program are subject to reimbursement under sub. (5).
