## 1987 Wisconsin Act 254

AN ACT to amend 70.47 (1) of the statutes, relating to meetings of boards of review.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 70.47 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

70.47 (1) TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING. The board of review shall meet annually <u>at any time during the 7-day period beginning</u> on the 2nd Monday of May. In towns and villages the board shall meet at the town or

village hall or some place designated by the town or village board. If there is no such hall, it shall meet at the clerk's office, or in towns at the place where the last annual town meeting was held. In cities the board shall meet at the council chamber or some place designated by the council and in cities of the 1st class in some place designated by the tax commissioner of such cities. A majority shall constitute a quorum except that 2 members may hold any hearing of the - 979 -

evidence required to be held by such board under subs. (8) and (10), if the requirements of sub. (9) are met.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect on the first May 1 after publication.
