## 1987 Wisconsin Act 261

AN ACT to amend 343.63 (3) (intro.), (4) and (5); and to create 343.63 (5m) of the statutes, relating to licensing of driver school instructors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.63 (3) (intro.), (4) and (5) of the statutes are amended to read:

343.63 (3) (intro.) The Except for an applicant for an instructor's license which is restricted to classroom instruction, the applicant must pass a psychophysical test with the following grades:

- (4) The applicant shall submit with his <u>or her</u> application a statement completed by a registered physician showing that <u>he</u> in the physician's judgment the applicant is physically fit to teach driving.
- (5) No Except for a license which is restricted to classroom instruction, no license shall be issued to an applicant who has suffered an amputation or loss of

the full use of either upper limb, or <u>loss of</u> the natural use of the foot normally employed to operate the foot brake and foot accelerator.

SECTION 2. 343.63 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

343.63 (5m) The department may issue an instructor's license which is restricted to classroom instruction to an applicant who does not otherwise qualify for a license because of a test result under sub. (3) or because the applicant has suffered an amputation or loss of the full use of either upper limb or loss of the natural use of the foot normally employed to operate the foot brake and foot accelerator, as specified in sub. (5).
