1987 Wisconsin Act 301

AN ACT to amend 125.04 (8) of the statutes, relating to payment of fees for licenses to sell alcohol beverages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.04 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.04 (8) (title) PAYMENT OF LICENSE FEE. No license for the sale of alcohol beverages may be delivered to the applicant until the applicant files with the

municipal clerk a receipt showing payment of the license fee to the appropriate treasurer. No city or village may require an applicant to pay the license fee more than 15 days prior to the date the license is to be issued. No town may require an applicant to pay the license fee more than 30 days prior to the date the license is to be issued.
