1987 Wisconsin Act 321

AN ACT to amend 101.14 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to inspections by fire chiefs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 101.14 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

101.14 (2) (b) Such chief of the fire department is required, by himself or by officers or members of his fire department designated by him for that purpose, to inspect all buildings, premises, and public thorough-

fares, except the interiors of private dwellings, for the purpose of ascertaining and causing to be corrected any conditions liable to cause fire, or any violations of any law or ordinance relating to the fire hazard or to the prevention of fires. The fire chief or his or her designee may not be required, under this paragraph, to inspect public spectator seating facilities except for the purposes set forth in this paragraph.
