## 1987 Wisconsin Act **71**

AN ACT *to amend* 757.69 (3) (h) of the statutes, *relating to* powers of court commissioners in proceedings supplementary to execution.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 757.69 (3) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

757.69 (3) (h) Conduct supplementary hearings on the present financial status of a debtor and exercise the powers of the court under ss. 816.04, 816.08 and 816.11.

NOTE: Section 757.69 (3) (h), stats., is amended to clarify that a court commissioner who conducts a hearing on the present

financial status of a judgment debtor may appoint a receiver in aid of execution, direct the application of nonexempt assets to the satisfaction of the judgment, and allow fees, costs and disbursements to the judgment creditor or any party at the hearing.
