1989 WISCONSIN ACT 142

AN ACT to create 971.17 (1g) and 973.033 of the statutes, **relating to:** informing defendants about firearm possession prohibitions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 971.17 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:

971.17 (1g) If the defendant under sub. (1) is found not guilty of a felony by reason of mental disease or

defect, the court shall inform the defendant of the requirements and penalties under s. 941.29.

SECTION 2. 973.033 of the statutes is created to read:
973.033 Sentencing; restriction on firearm possession. Whenever a court imposes a sentence or places a defendant on probation regarding a felony conviction, the court shall inform the defendant of the requirements and penalties under s. 941.29.
