# 1989 WISCONSIN ACT 181

AN ACT to amend 36.27 (2) (cm) of the statutes, relating to: eligibility for exemption from nonresident tuition at the university of Wisconsin system.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** 36.27 (2) (cm) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.27 (2) (cm) Any person continuously employed full time by a private business located in this state, who was relocated to this state for business purposes by his or her current employer or who moved to this state for busi-

ness employment purposes and accepted his or her current employment before applying for admission to an institution or center and before moving, and the spouse and dependents of any such person, are entitled to the exemption under par. (a) if the student demonstrates an intent to establish and maintain a permanent home in Wisconsin according to the criteria under par. (e). In this paragraph, "dependents" has the meaning given in 26 USC 152 (a).
