1989 WISCONSIN ACT 225

AN ACT *to renumber* 103.01 (1), 103.15 (1) (a) and 104.01 (3); and *to create* 103.01 (1) (b), 103.15 (1) (a) and 104.01 (3) (b) of the statutes, **relating to:** the definition of employer under the minimum wage and hours of labor and under the restrictions on use of tests for HIV laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 103.01 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 103.01 (1) (a).

SECTION 2. 103.01 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

103.01 (1) (b) “Employer” includes the state, its political subdivisions and any office, department, independent agency, authority, institution, association, society or other body in state or local government created or authorized to be created by the constitution or any law, including the legislature and the courts.

SECTION 3. 103.15 (1) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 103.15 (1) (am).

SECTION 4. 103.15 (1) (a) of the statutes is created to read:

103.15 (1) (a) “Employer” includes the state, its political subdivisions and any office, department, independent agency, authority, institution, association, society or other body in state or local government created or authorized to be created by the constitution or any law, including the legislature and the courts.

SECTION 5. 104.01 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 104.01 (3) (a).

SECTION 6. 104.01 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

104.01 (3) (b) “Employer” includes the state, its political subdivisions and any office, department, independent agency, authority, institution, association, society or other body in state or local government created or authorized to be created by the constitution or any law, including the legislature and the courts.
