1989 WISCONSIN ACT 24

AN ACT to create 38.22 (1s) of the statutes, relating to: admission requirements for vocational, technical and adult education schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 38.22 (1s) of the statutes is created to read:

38.22 (1s) Notwithstanding sub. (1) (intro.), an individual under the age of 16 is eligible to attend the schools of a district if all of the following apply:

- (a) The district board agrees to admit the individual.
 - (b) The individual satisfies the other requirements for admission under sub. (1).
 - (c) The individual has the written permission of his or her parent or guardian.
 - (d) The individual will not be attending the district school during the hours of the normal school day established under s. 119.18 (7) or 120.12 (15).
