1989 WISCONSIN ACT 367

AN ACT relating to reimbursement to counties for general relief expenditures, an audit of the Milwaukee county general relief program and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; audit. The legislative audit bureau shall conduct a financial and performance audit of the general relief program in Milwaukee county and submit a report summarizing the results of the audit to the committees specified under section 13.94 (1) (b) of the statutes by January 1, 1991.

SECTION 1m. Appropriation changes; health and social services. The dollar amount in the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health and social services under section 20.435 (7) (eb) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1989, is increased by \$3,350,000 for fiscal year 1989-90 to increase the funding for reimbursement to counties for general relief expenditures.
