1989 WISCONSIN ACT 67

AN ACT to amend 36.27 (3) (g); and to create 36.05 (9m) of the statutes, relating to: tuition remissions for graduate students employed as faculty or instructional academic staff members in the university of Wisconsin system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.05 (9m) of the statutes is created to read:

36.05 (9m) "Instructional academic staff" means academic staff members with teaching responsibilities.

SECTION 2. 36.27 (3) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.27 (3) (g) The board may remit nonresident tuition, in whole or part, to graduate students who are fellows or who are employed within the system as faculty, instructional academic staff or assistants with an appointment equal to at least 33% of a full-time equivalent position.

SECTION 3. Initial applicability. (1) TUITION REMISSION. The treatment of section 36.27 (3) (g) of the statutes first applies to tuition remissions for the semester commencing after the effective date of this subsection.
