1989 WISCONSIN ACT 73

AN ACT *to amend* 29.09 (3) (c) and 29.103 (4) (b) 1; *to repeal and recreate* 29.103 (4) (c); and *to create* 29.103 (1) (d) of the statutes, **relating to:** wild turkey hunting permits and stamps.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.09 (3) (c) of the statutes, as created by 1989 Wisconsin Act 31, is amended to read:

29.09 (3) (c) *Wild turkey hunting stamps.* Each wild turkey hunting stamp shall bear upon its face a true signature of the person to whom it is issued ~~and the words "Turkey Permit"~~.

SECTION 1m. 29.103 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

29.103 (1) (d) "Resident applicant" includes a qualified resident landowner who applies for a wild turkey hunting permit.

SECTION 2. 29.103 (4) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

29.103 (4) (b) 1. If the department requires wild turkey hunting permits, the department shall give first preference in the issuance of these permits, ~~but not to exceed 20% of all permits to be issued in any established wild turkey hunting zone, shall be given~~ to applicants applying under the landowner preference system. The number of permits issued under this section for a season for an established wild turkey hunting zone may not

exceed 30% of all permits issued for that season in that zone.

SECTION 3. 29.103 (4) (c) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

29.103 (4) (c) *Other preferences.* If the department requires wild turkey hunting permits, the department shall give, in the issuance of these permits:

1. Second preference to resident applicants who applied for but who were not issued wild turkey hunting permits:

a. For the previous season if the department establishes one open season per year; or

b. For the previous corresponding season if the department establishes more than one open season per year.

2. Third preference to all other resident applicants.

3. Fourth preference to nonresident applicants.

SECTION 4. Initial applicability. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this act first applies to any wild turkey permit issued on November 3, 1989, or the effective date of this subsection, whichever is later.

(2) The treatment of section 29.09 (3) (c) of the statutes first applies to any wild turkey stamps issued on March 1, 1990, or the effective date of this subsection, whichever is later.
