1991 WISCONSIN ACT 132

AN ACT to amend 230.14 (3m) of the statutes, relating to: recruitment for vacancies in the classified civil service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.14 (3m) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.14 (**3m**) In advertising openings in the classified civil service, the state may not require as a condition of

application that an applicant be a college graduate unless the opening must be filled by an incumbent holding a credential, as defined in s. 440.01 (2) (a), or other license, permit, certificate or registration in an occupation regulated by law and college graduation is required to obtain the occupational credential, license, permit, certificate or registration.
