1991 WISCONSIN ACT 132

AN ACT to amend 230.14 (3m) of the statutes, relating to: recruitment for vacancies in the classified civil service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.14 (3m) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.14 (**3m**) In advertising openings in the classified civil service, the state may not require as a condition of

application that an applicant be a college graduate unless the opening must be filled by an incumbent holding a <u>credential</u>, as defined in s. 440.01 (2) (a), or other license, <u>permit</u>, <u>certificate</u> or registration in an occupation regulated by law and college graduation is required to obtain the occupational <u>credential</u>, license, <u>permit</u>, <u>certificate</u> or registration.
