1991 WISCONSIN ACT 147

AN ACT to *repeal and recreate* 230.03 (14) of the statutes, **relating to:** eligibility for civil service veterans' preference points.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.03 (14) of the statutes, as created by 1991 Wisconsin Act (SB-255), is repealed and recreated to read:

230.03 (14) Except as provided in s. 230.16 (7m), veteran means any of the following:

(a) A person who served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces and who was entitled to receive any of the following:

1. The armed forces expeditionary medal established by executive order 10977 on December 4, 1961.

2. The Vietnam service medal established by executive order 11231 on July 8, 1965.

3. The navy expeditionary medal.

4. The marine corps expeditionary medal.

(b) A person who served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces in Grenada, Lebanon, Panama or a Middle East crisis under s. 45.34.

(c) A person who served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces for at least one day during a war period, as defined in s. 45.35 (5) (a) to (g) or under section 1 of executive order 10957 dated August 10, 1961.
