1991 WISCONSIN ACT 209

AN ACT *to create* 227.11 (2) (e) of the statutes, **relating to:** prohibiting a state agency from informing the public in writing that a rule is or will be in effect unless the agency has completed its rule–making process or is requested to provide that information.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 227.11 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

227.11 (2) (e) An agency may not inform a member of the public in writing that a rule is or will be in effect unless the rule has been filed under s. 227.20 or unless the member of the public requests that information.
