1991 WISCONSIN ACT 212

AN ACT to amend 15.105 (8) of the statutes, relating to: membership of the arts board and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.105 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.105 (8) ARTS BOARD. There is created an arts board which is attached to the department of administration under s. 15.03. The arts board shall consist of 42 <u>15</u> members appointed for staggered 3-year terms who are residents of this state and who are known for their concern for the arts. At least 2 members shall be from the northwest portion of this state, at least 2 members shall be from the northeast portion of this state, at least 2 members shall be from the southwest portion of this state and at least 2 members shall be from the southwest portion of this state.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions; arts board membership. (1) Notwithstanding section 15.105 (8) of the statutes, as affected by this act, one of the new members appointed to the arts board under that section shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 1993, one

shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 1994, and one shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 1995.

(2) ARTS BOARD MEMBERSHIP. Notwithstanding section 15.105 (8) of the statutes, as affected by this act, any member of the arts board on the effective date of this subsection may continue to serve until the expiration of his or her term and the appointment and qualification of a successor. The governor, in making nominations to membership on the arts board after the effective date of this subsection shall, to the maximum extent possible, comply with the requirements of section 15.105 (8) of the statutes, as affected by this act.

SECTION 3. Appropriation changes. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the arts board under section 20.215 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1991, the dollar amount is increased by \$5,000 for fiscal year 1991–92 and the dollar amount is increased by \$5,000 for fiscal year 1992–93 to fund the additional members of the arts board.
