1991 WISCONSIN ACT 72

AN ACT *to amend* 348.07 (1) and 348.08 (1) (a) of the statutes, **relating to:** the length of certain vehicles and combinations of vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 348.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.07(1) No person, without a permit therefor, may operate on a highway any single vehicle with an overall length in excess of 40 feet or any combination of 2

vehicles with an overall length in excess of $\frac{60}{65}$ feet, except as otherwise provided in subs. (2) and (2a).

SECTION 4. 348.08(1)(a) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.08 (1) (a) Two <u>or 3</u> vehicles may, without such permit, be drawn or attached when such vehicles are being transported by the drive–away method in <u>saddle–mount saddlemount</u> combination and the overall length of such combination of vehicles does not exceed 65 feet.
