## **1991 WISCONSIN ACT 86**

AN ACT to repeal 343.50 (9); to renumber 343.50 (8); to amend 343.50 (2) and 343.50 (8) (title); and to create 343.50 (8) (b) and 345.54 (5) of the statutes, relating to: the age for obtaining identification cards issued by the department of transportation and disclosure of records, other information concerning identification cards and postponing implementation of automatic reinstatement assessments for the suspension of motor vehicle operating privileges.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 343.50 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.50 (2) WHO MAY APPLY. Any resident of this state who is at least 16 years of age and who does not possess a valid operator's license which contains the resident's photograph issued under this chapter may apply to the department for an identification card pursuant to this section. The card is not a license for purposes of this chapter and is to be used for identification purposes only.

**SECTION 2.** 343.50 (8) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.50 (8) (title) RECORDS AND OTHER INFORMATION. **SECTION 3.** 343.50 (8) of the statutes is renumbered 343.50 (8) (a).

**SECTION 4.** 343.50 (8) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

343.50 (8) (b) The department shall not disclose any record or other information concerning or relating to an applicant or identification card holder to any person other than a court, district attorney, county corporation counsel, city, village or town attorney, law enforcement agency, the applicant or identification card holder or, if the applicant or identification card holder is under 18 years of age, his or her parent or guardian. Persons entitled to receive any record or other information under this paragraph shall not disclose the record or other information to other persons or agencies.

SECTION 4g. 343.50 (9) of the statutes is repealed.

**SECTION 4m.** 345.54 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

345.54 (5) This section applies after December 31, 1992.

**SECTION 4r. Effective date.** This act takes effect on December 1, 1991, or the day after publication, whichever is later.
