1991 WISCONSIN ACT 96

AN ACT to create 46.95 (2) (g) 13 of the statutes, relating to: funding for a 24-hour telephone service operated at a domestic abuse shelter and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 46.95 (2) (g) 13. of the statutes is created to read:

46.95 (2) (g) 13. Allocate \$10,000 in each fiscal year for a grant to a 36-bed domestic abuse shelter in the city of Milwaukee for a 24-hour telephone service operated at the shelter to respond to domestic violence arrests.

SECTION 2. Appropriation changes; health and

social services. (1) DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOTLINE. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health and social services under section 20.435 (7) (cb) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1991, the dollar amount is increased by \$5,000 for fiscal year 1991-92 and the dollar amount is increased by \$10,000 for fiscal year 1992-93 to fund a 24-hour telephone service operated at a 36-bed domestic abuse shelter in the city of Milwaukee to respond to domestic violence arrests.
