1993 WISCONSIN ACT 153

AN ACT *to renumber* 29.145 (2); *to amend* 29.092 (2) (a), 29.092 (3) (a) and 29.145 (1) (b) 2; and *to create* 29.092 (3v) (b) and 29.145 (2) (b) of the statutes, **relating to:** annual fishing licenses issued to residents who are 16 or 17 years of age.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.092 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.092 (2) (a) *Resident small game.* Except as provided in sub. (3v) (a) 1., the fee for a resident small game hunting license is \$10.25.

SECTION 2. 29.092 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.092 (3) (a) *Resident annual.* Except as provided in sub. (3v) (a) 2. and (b)., the fee for a resident annual fishing license is \$11.25.

SECTION 3. 29.092 (3v) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

29.092 (3v) (b) The fee for a resident annual fishing license issued to a resident aged 16 or 17 is \$4.25.

SECTION 4. 29.145 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

29.145 (1) (b) 2. Notwithstanding s. 29.092 (3v) (a) 2., no fishing license is required for any resident born before January 1, 1927, to fish for fish subject to all other provisions of law.

SECTION 5. 29.145 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 29.145 (2) (a).

SECTION 6. 29.145 (2) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

29.145 (2) (b) A resident annual fishing license issued to any resident who is 16 or 17 years of age shall be issued at the reduced fee under s. 29.092 (3v) (b).

SECTION 7. Effective date. This act takes effect on April 1, 1995.
