1993 WISCONSIN ACT 179

AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 218.04 (2); and *to create* 218.04 (2) (b) of the statutes, **relating to:** licensing requirements for nonresident collection agencies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 218.04 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 218.04 (2) (a) and amended to read:

218.04 (2) (a) ~~No~~ Except as provided in par. (b), a person ~~shall~~ may not operate as a collection agency or as a collector or solicitor in this state without first having

obtained a license as required by this section.

SECTION 2. 218.04 (2) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

218.04 (2) (b) A nonresident of this state is not required to obtain a collection agency license if that person conducts collection business with state residents solely by means of interstate telecommunications or interstate mail.
