1993 WISCONSIN ACT 209

AN ACT to amend 46.058 (2), 46.16 (1) and 140.055 (1) of the statutes, relating to: deleting obsolete titles of certain institutions administered or formerly administered by counties and by the department of health and social services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 46.058 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

46.058 (2) The superintendent superintendents of all the state charitable, curative and reformatory institutions administered by the department and of all county hospitals and county homes, and the employes under them to whom they delegate police power, may arrest any person within or upon the grounds of such institutions whom they have reason to believe is guilty of any offense against the laws or regulations governing the institutions; and for that purpose they shall possess the powers of constables.

SECTION 2. 46.16 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

46.16 (1) GENERALLY. The department shall investigate and supervise all the charitable, curative and reformatory institutions, including county infirmaries, of every county and municipality, except tuberculosis sanatoriums; all shelter care facilities for children and all industrial schools, hospitals, asylums and institutions, organized for the purpose set forth in s. 58.01, and familiarize itself with all the circumstances affecting their management and usefulness.

SECTION 3. 140.055 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

140.055 (1) The department shall investigate and supervise the sanitary conditions of all the charitable, curative, reformatory and penal institutions of every county and other municipality, all detention homes for children and all industrial schools, hospitals, asylums and institutions, organized for the purposes set forth in s. 58.01.
