1993 WISCONSIN ACT 21

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$8,659.33 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state made by Tom Kuenster.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.115 (2) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1991 and 1993, \$8,659.33 in payment of a claim against the state made by Tom Kuenster, Glen Haven,

Wisconsin, to compensate him for the difference in value of his swine that were ordered to be destroyed by the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection in October 1991, for which he was reimbursed under former law and the value for which he would have been reimbursed under section 95.27 (4) of the 1991 statutes. Acceptance of this payment releases this state from any further liability resulting from this order.
