## **1993 WISCONSIN ACT 220**

AN ACT to amend 948.11 (2) (a) and 948.11 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to: renting harmful material to children.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 948.11 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

948.11 (2) (a) Whoever, with knowledge of the nature of the material, sells, <u>rents</u>, exhibits, transfers or loans to a child any material which is harmful to children, with or without monetary consideration, is guilty of a Class E felony.

**SECTION 2.** 948.11 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

948.11 (2) (b) Whoever, with knowledge of the nature of the material, possesses material which is harmful to children with the intent to sell, <u>rent</u>, exhibit, transfer or loan the material to a child is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

**SECTION 3.** Initial applicability. This act first applies to offenses occurring on the effective date of this SECTION.
