1993 WISCONSIN ACT 231

AN ACT to create 46.18 (15) and 59.07 (96m) of the statutes, relating to: permitting trustees of a county hospital to join with a public or private organization or affiliation to provide a health–related service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 46.18 (15) of the statutes is created to read:

46.18 (15) JOINT OPERATION OF HEALTH–RELATED SER-VICE. If the county board of supervisors so authorizes, the trustees of the county hospital may, together with a private or public organization or affiliation, organize, establish and participate in the governance and operation of an entity to operate, wholly or in part, any health–related service, may participate in the financing of the entity and may provide administrative and financial services or resources for its operation on terms prescribed by the county board of supervisors.

SECTION 2. 59.07 (96m) of the statutes is created to read:

59.07 (96m) JOINT OPERATION OF HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE. May authorize the trustees of county hospitals, together with a private or public organization or affiliation, to organize, establish and participate in the governance and operation of an entity to operate, wholly or in part, any health–related service; to participate in the financing of the entity; and to provide administrative and financial services or resources for its operation on terms prescribed by the county board.
