1993 WISCONSIN ACT 240

AN ACT *to repeal and recreate* 166.20 (5) (a) 4 of the statutes, **relating to:** requiring additional types of facilities to complete toxic chemical release forms and submit them to the department of natural resources.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 166.20 (5) (a) 4. of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

166.20 (5) (a) 4. The following facilities shall comply with the toxic chemical release form requirements under 42 USC 11023 and shall submit copies of all toxic chemical release forms to the department of natural resources:

- a. All facilities subject to 42 USC 11023.
- b. All public agencies and private agencies at which a toxic chemical is used at or above an applicable threshold quantity.

- c. All facilities with 10 or more employees in major group classifications 10 to 13 in the standard industrial classification manual, 1987 edition, published by the U.S. office of management and budget, at which a toxic chemical is used at or above an applicable threshold quantity, except that compliance with the toxic chemical release form requirements under this subd. 4. c. is not required for the placement of a toxic chemical in a storage or disposal site or facility that is located at a facility with a permit under ss. 144.80 to 144.94 if the toxic chemical consists of or is contained in merchantable by-products as defined in s. 144.81 (3), minerals as defined in s. 144.81 (4) or refuse as defined in s. 144.81 (17).
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
