1993 WISCONSIN ACT 248

AN ACT to amend 83.05 (2) of the statutes, relating to: the county share of certain city and village street improvements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 83.05 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

83.05 (2) Upon the completion of the work the county's share of the cost shall be paid to the contractor as though the county had been an immediate party to the contract. In no case shall <u>Unless specifically authorized by the county</u>, the payment by the county <u>shall not</u> exceed the cost of <u>18 22</u> feet of the width of the pavement, plus a share as well as a portion of the <u>costs of</u> grading, draining, and appertaining structures, which share shall be

determined by dividing the whole cost of these items by the width of the pavement in feet and multiplying the quotient by 18. The balance of the expense of the improvement shall be borne by the city, and shall be provided in the manner in which expense of street improvement is ordinarily met. Assessments of benefits may be made by the city against abutting property in the manner provided where the improvement is done solely at the expense of the city, but such assessments of benefits shall not exceed the difference between the cost of the improvement and the amount contributed thereto by the county.
