1993 WISCONSIN ACT 347

AN ACT to create 84.103 (1t) of the statutes, relating to: designating a certain highway route as the “Purple Heart Memorial Highway”.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 84.103 (1t) of the statutes is created to read:

84.103 (1t) PURPLE HEART MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. The department shall designate USH 14 commencing at the Wisconsin–Minnesota border and proceeding easterly to

Richland Center as the “Purple Heart Memorial Highway” as a permanent memorial to and in honor of all persons wounded, injured or killed as the direct result of enemy action who have been awarded this high honor in the name of the president of the United States. The department shall erect a permanent memorial marker along this route to identify the designation of the highway under this subsection.
