1993 WISCONSIN ACT 36

AN ACT to *repeal* 196.202 (3); and to *amend* 196.202 (4) (a) of the statutes, **relating to**: cellular telephone regulation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 196.202 (3) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 196.202 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

196.202 (4) (a) On the first day of the first January following the date on which subscribers to all cellular

mobile radio telecommunications utilities in a geographic service area, defined by the federal communications commission under 47 USC 154 (i), this state constitute ~~7%~~ 10% or more of the population ~~in that service area of this state~~, every cellular mobile radio telecommunications utility providing service in ~~that area~~ this state is subject to s. 196.203.
