

1993 Senate Bill 824

Date of enactment: **May 27, 1994**
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1993 WISCONSIN ACT 484

AN ACT *to repeal* 243.10 (1) (c); *to repeal and recreate* 243.10 (18); and *to create* 243.10 (1) (cm) of the statutes, relating to: recording the statutory form of power of attorney in the office of the register of deeds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 243.10 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 1993 Wisconsin Act 299, is repealed.

SECTION 2. 243.10 (1) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:

243.10 (1) (cm) *Recording.* A completed statutory form of power of attorney may be recorded in the office of the register of deeds in the county where the principal resides and in the county where the agent resides.

SECTION 3. 243.10 (18) of the statutes, as affected by 1993 Wisconsin Acts 148 and 299, is repealed and recreated to read:

243.10 (18) REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY. A principal may revoke his or her power of attorney and invalidate the power of attorney at any time by executing a statement, in writing, that is signed and dated by the principal, expressing the principal's intent to revoke the power of attorney. The statement may be recorded in the office of the register of deeds in the same counties where the statutory form of power of attorney was recorded under sub. (1) (cm).

SECTION 4. Effective dates. This act takes effect retroactively to March 26, 1994, except as follows:

(1) The treatment of section 243.10 (1) (c) of the statutes takes effect retroactively to April 29, 1994.
