1993 WISCONSIN ACT 51

AN ACT to amend 978.047 of the statutes, relating to: appointment of investigators to assist district attorneys.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 978.047 of the statutes is amended to read:

978.047 Investigators; police powers. The district

attorney of any county having a population of 500,000 or more or containing a 2nd or 3rd class city may appoint such investigators as are authorized by the county board, and the county board may abolish the positions at its pleasure. The investigators when so appointed have general police powers within the county.
