1993 WISCONSIN ACT 66

AN ACT to amend 459.24 (2) (e) of the statutes, relating to: requirements for applicants for a speech-language pathologist license.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 459.24 (2) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

459.24 (2) (e) Submits evidence satisfactory to the examining board that he or she has passed the examination required for certification as a speech-language

pathologist by the American speech–language–hearing association or passes an examination under s. 459.26 to determine fitness as a speech–language pathologist <u>or has completed education or training that the examining board determines is substantially equivalent to passing one of those examinations in determining fitness as a speech–language pathologist.</u>
