1995 WISCONSIN ACT 300

AN ACT to amend 940.22 (2) of the statutes; relating to: sexual exploitation by a therapist and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 940.22 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

940.22 (2) SEXUAL CONTACT PROHIBITED. Any person who is or who holds himself or herself out to be a therapist and who intentionally has sexual contact with a patient or

client during any ongoing therapist-patient or therapistclient relationship, regardless of whether it occurs during any treatment, consultation, interview or examination, is guilty of a Class $D \underline{C}$ felony. Consent is not an issue in an action under this subsection.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to offenses occurring on the effective date of this subsection.
