2009 WISCONSIN ACT 143

AN ACT *to amend* 35.01 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** the exemption of State Historical Society books from state printing requirements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 35.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.01 (3) Class 3—All book printing required for state agencies, not otherwise classified, except university press publications and technical or semitechnical journals of the University of Wisconsin System, the Wisconsin ~~magazine of history~~ Magazine of History, and ~~hard bound~~ books of the historical society.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 2007–08 : Effective date of acts. “Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor’s partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated” by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
