Rates of contribution to administra-tion fund Forms

Ind-UC/150.01 Commission reports to federal agencies. Section 108.20  $\langle (\Upsilon)$ , Wis. Stats., relating to the special fund established for the commission's administration of the Wisconsin unemployment compensation act, provides in part as follows: "This fund shall consist of all federal moneys allotted or apportioned to the state or the commission for the administration of this chapter, and the commission is hereby directed to make to federal agencies such reports as are necessary in connection with or because of such federal aid." The clear intent of this language was to accept any federal aid available to the state under title III of the federal social security act, and to direct the commission to make to federal agencies all reports necessary for this purpose, consistently with paragraphs (6) and (7) of subsection (a) of section 303 of the federal social security act. Accordingly, section 108.20 (1), Wis. Stats., shall be administered in accordance with the following provisions:

(1) The commission shall make such reports relating to chapter 108 Wis. Stats., in such form and containing such information, as the secretary of labor may from time to time require, and shall comply with such provisions as the secretary of labor may from time to time find necessary to assure the correctness and verification of such reports: and

(2) The commission shall make available upon request to any agency of the United States charged with the administration of public works or assistance through public employment, the name, address, ordinary occupation and employment status of each recipient of unemployment compensation, and a statement/of such recipient's rights to further compensation under chapter 108, Wis. Stats.

Ind-UC 150.03 Rates of contribution to administration fund. Starting July 1, 1938, the following provisions of this section shall apply in relation to contributions to the administration fund under section 108,19/ Wis. Stats. The commission hereby prescribes the following rates of contribution to the unemployment administration fund, to apply to the following classes of employers, with respect to their "defined payroll" for the several months from July 1938 on, until further notice:

(1) No contribution to the unemployment administration fund shall be required in the case of any employer who has an account in the unemployment reserve fund created by section 108.16, Wis. Stats. Ind-UC 150.05 Forms. The following forms, used by the commission, are listed herewith in accordance with section 227.013, Wis. Stats. Each form here listed is issued by the commission's unemployment compensation department, 137 East Wilson Street, Madison 1, Wisconsin. Any such form needed by any individual may be obtained by writing the commission's U.C. Department at that address.
