PSC 55.01 Transporting intrastate shipments over state line prohibited; exceptions

PSC 55.01 Transporting intrastate shipments over state line prohibited; exceptions. Each common motor carrier of property in intrastate commerce in Wisconsin shall cease and desist from transporting over the boundary line of the state of Wisconsin any shipment tendered to it for transportation between any two Wisconsin points on its line or between any Wisconsin point on its line and any Wisconsin point on the line of any other common motor carrier where wholly intrastate single- or joint-line routes are available and where rates for such intrastate transportation are on file with the commission except under the following conditions:

- (1) Where the shipper in writing specifies an interstate route;
- (2) Where the traffic originates or terminates at a Wisconsin point lying within, or contiguous to, a multiple state commercial zone or terminal area established by the interstate commerce commission or contiguous to an out-of-state municipality in which the carrier maintains terminal facilities;
- (3) When, in the public interest, the commission by order upon proper application and good cause shown shall otherwise provide.
