WCD 40.01 State forests. All state-owned forest lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the state conservation commission, located within the following areas, are established and designated as state forests.

(1) AMERICAN LEGION STATE FOREST. Beginning at the northeast corner of section 1, township 39 north, range 9 east;

thence west along the township line between townships 39 and 40 north, which is the county line between Vilas and Oneida counties, to the northwest corner of section 6, township 39 north, range 7 east;

thence south along the range line between ranges 6 and 7 east to the southwest corner of section 31, township 38 north, range 7 east;

thence east along the township line between townships 37 and 38 north to the southeast corner of section 36, township 38 north, range 7 east;

thence north along the range line between ranges 7 and 8 east to the southeast corner of section 12, township 38 north, range 7 east;

thence east on section lines to the southeast corner of section 9, township 38 north, range 8 east;

thence south on section lines to the southwest corner of section 22, township 38 north, range 8 east;

thence east on section lines to the southeast corner of section 20, township 38 north, range 9 east;

thence north on section lines to the southeast corner of section 29, township 39 north, range 9 east;

thence east on section lines to the southeast corner of section 25, township 39 north, range 9 east;

thence north along the range line between ranges 9 and 10 east to the place of beginning, except lots 3, 4, 6 and 7 of section 8, and lots 2 and 3 of section 17, township 38 north, range 7 east.

All lying in Oneida county, Wisconsin.

(2) BRULE RIVER STATE FOREST. Beginning at the northeast corner of section 13, township 47 north, range 10 west, Douglas county;

thence west on section line to the northwest corner of said section 13;

thence north on section lines to the shore of Lake Superior;

thence southwesterly along the south shore of Lake Superior to a point where the section line between sections 8 and 17, township 49 north, range 10 west, meets the shore of said lake;

thence east on section lines to the northwest corner of section 15, township 49 north, range 10 west;

thence west on section lines to the northwest corner of section 17, township 46 north, range 10 west;

thence west to the northwest corner of section 25, township 46 north, range 11 west;

thence south to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section 26, township 46 north, range 11 west;

thence west along the quarter lines to the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section 27, township 46 north, range 11 west;

thence north on section lines to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section 21, township 46 north, range 11 west;

thence west along the quarter line to the shore of Lake Minnesuing in said section 21;

thence westerly and northerly along the south and west shore of Lake Minnesuing to a point where the east-west quarter line of section 16, township 46 north, range 11 west, meets the west shore of said lake;

thence west along the quarter line to the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of said section 16;

thence south on section lines to the northeast corner of section 5, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence west on section lines to the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of section 6, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence south along the quarter line to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of section 7, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence east to the northwest corner of section 17, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence south to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section 17;

thence east to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said section 17;

thence north to the center of said section 17;

thence east along the quarter line to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of said section 17;

thence north to the southwest corner of section 9, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence east on section line to the southeast corner of said section 9; thence north to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of section 10, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence east along the quarter lines to the center of section 12, township 45 north, range 11 west;

thence north along the quarter lines to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of section 36, township 46 north, range 11 west;

(3) POINT BEACH STATE FOREST: Beginning at the northeast corner of government lot 4, on the shores of Lake Michigan, in section 4, township 20 north, range 25 east, Manitowoc county;

thence west to the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 5, township 20 north, range 25 east;

thence south two and one-quarter miles to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter section 17, township 20 north, range 25 east;

thence east along the section line between sections 17 and 20, onehalf mile more or less to a point in the center of the Point Beach state forest road;

thence southwesterly along the Point Beach state forest road 2,250 feet more or less to a point in the center of the road;

thence south 76°30' east 450 feet;

thence south 28°30' west 700 feet;

thence south 76°30' east 285 feet;

thence south 28°30' west 672 feet;

thence north 76°30' west 735 feet; to the center of the Point Beach state forest road;

WCD 40.04 Black River State Forest. The lands within the boundaries hereinafter described in the counties of Jackson and Clark are hereby created, established and designated as the Black River State Forest:

thence west on section lines to the westernmost juncture with the Black River in Section 6, T22N, R2W;

thence northwesterly along the south shore of the Black River to Arbutus Lake;

thence southwesterly along the shore of Arbutus Lake and the south shore of the Black River to the point of intersection with the ¼ section line of Section 17, T22N, R3W;

thence west along the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section line to the west line of said section 17;

thence southward and westward along the existing roadway to the center of Section 36, T22N, R4W;

WCD 40.05 Apostle Islands State Forest. All state-owned lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the state conservation commission within the boundaries hereinafter described in Ashland county are hereby created, established and designated as the Apostle Islands State Forest.

(1) STOCKTON ISLAND. An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county, commonly known and referred to as Stockton Island, and located in Townships 51 and 52 North, Ranges 1 and 2 West.

(2) OAK ISLAND. An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county and commonly known and referred to as Oak Island and located in townships 51 and 52 North, Range 3 West.

(3) BASSWOOD ISLAND. An island in Lake Superior situated in Ashland county and commonly known and referred to as Basswood Island and located in Townships 50 and 51 North, Range 3 West. **History:** Cr. Register, April, 1959, No. 40, eff. 5-1-59.
