Ind 69.30 Shop inspections. (1) Inspection of boilers, pressure vessels, elevators, dumbwaiters, moving ramps, personnel hoists, and similar devices, and parts of such devices, may be provided at reasonable times and at the place of manufacture on request, but only when deemed by the department of industry, labor and human relations to be essential and necessary.

(2) Fees to be assessed and collected for shop inspections shall be as follows:

Ind 69.50 Certificates of competency. (1) Insurance company employes eligible in accordance with the provisions of the applicable administrative code, to be examined for competency as a boiler inspector or as an elevator inspector shall submit with the proper application forms an examination fee of \$30.

(a) Boiler inspectors receiving a reciprocal "certificate of competency" by qualifying as a member of the "National Board of Boiler and Unfired Pressure Vessel Inspectors" shall submit with their application form a fee of \$25.

(b) An applicant who fails the scheduled examination need not submit an additional examination fee when application for reexamination is filed within 12 months from the date of the previous examination. (2) The annual renewal fee for certificates of competency shall be \$10.
