COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNATION OF
LEGAL HOLIDAYS

S-L 7.01 Designated legal holidays

S-L 7.01 Designated legal holidays. (1) The commissioner of savings and loan associations, pursuant to section 215.26 (5), Wis. Stats., designates as legal holidays, the following days, set forth in section 256.17, Wis. Stats., on which no savings and loan association shall transact business or be open for the transaction of business:

- (a) January 1.
- (b) May 30.
- (c) July 4.
- (d) December 25.
- (e) First Monday in September (Labor Day).
- (f) Fourth Thursday of November or the day appointed by the governor as Thanksgiving Day.
- (g) Good Friday between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

(2) Whenever any of the legal holidays designated in Wis. Adm. Code subsection S-L 7.01(1), falls on a Sunday, no savings and loan association shall transact business or be open for the transaction of business on the succeeding Monday.

(3) Nothing herein shall be construed to compel any savings and loan association to be kept open for the transaction of business on a day which according to the provisions of section 256.17, Wis. Stats., is a legal holiday in the community in which the savings and loan association is located.
