APPLICATION FOR BENEFITS

- TR 6.01 Date application for annuity may be made
- TR 6.02 Changing type of benefit
- TR 6.03 Date annuity may become effective

TR 6.01 Date application for annuity may be made. A member may make formal application for an annuity at any time within 60 days prior to the date he desires his annuity to become effective.

TR 6.02 Changing type of benefit. An annuitant may not change from one type of annuity to another after the effective date of his annuity.

TR 6.03 Date annuity may become effective. An annuity cannot become effective prior to the first day of the month following the last day of teaching service, nor prior to the first day of the month in which a written application therefor is received in the office of the state teachers retirement system. An annuity shall be effective only on the first day of the month.
