Township 12 north, range 16 east, town of Williamstown.

Those parts of sections 29, 31 and 32 bounded by the following description: commencing at the northwest corner of the NE SE of section 31, township 12 north, range 16 east; thence south 621 feet; thence east 1300 feet; thence north 30 degrees east for a distance of 1300 feet; thence north 10 degrees east for a distance of 2,900 feet; thence west 400 feet; thence south 42 degrees west for a distance of 1718 feet; thence south 23 degrees west for a distance of 2145 feet to the place of beginning.

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armed forces of the national guard or the United States army, or any peace officers, or any person summoned by a peace officer to assist him in making an arrest or preserving the peace, from entering and being on such refuge in the performance of official duties.
