**NR 11.08 Closed area; waterfowl.** A closed season is established in the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds thereon during the periods established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01 as open seasons on waterfowl.

**NR 11.14 Closed area; waterfowl.** A closed season is established on the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of migratory birds including waterfowl thereon at any time.

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seasons on deer, and the open bow and arrow season on deer following such gun seasons, except migratory waterfowl during the periods established in Wisconsin Administrative Code section NR 10.01 (1) as open seasons for waterfowl.

**NR 11.26 Closed area; waterfowl retrieving zone.** A closed season is established in the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds thereon during the periods established in Wis. Adm. Code subsection NR 10.01 (1) as open seasons on waterfowl,

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except deer during the periods established in section NR 10.01 (3) (e) as open gun seasons on deer, and except that legally killed or crippled waterfowl may be retrieved by dog or hand.

#### (1) DODGE COUNTY. (a) Horicon Marsh state-owned land.

Township 12 north, range 16 east, town of Williamstown.

All state-owned land lying 300 feet south of the east-west center line of sections 7 and 8 and that part of section 9 lying 300 feet south of the west 2,035 feet of the east-west center line.
