NR 15.01 Game refuges, all species. The following described areas are created and established as game refuges and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to hunt or trap upon said areas or have in possession or under control thereon any gun or rifle unless the same is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case, or any bow and arrow unless the same is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case, but nothing herein shall prohibit, prevent or interfere with the department, its deputies, agents or employes in the destruction of injurious animals and birds. This section shall not prohibit the department, its deputies or duly authorized agents, the armed forces of the national guard or the United States army, or any peace officers, or any person summoned by a peace officer to assist him in making an arrest or preserving the peace, from entering and being on such refuges in the performance of official duties.
