Ag 18.01 Collective terms. (1) The collective terms, animal protein products, forage products, grain products, plant protein products, processed grain by-products, and roughage products may be used on feed labels to describe one or more ingredients performing a similar function as set forth herein, without listing each of the ingredients individually.

- (2) The collective terms and the group of ingredients for which each may be used are:

Ag 18.02 Ingredient labeling restrictions. (1) Collective terms may not be used to describe ingredients other than those specified under s.

- (2) When a collective term is used on a feed label to describe one or more ingredients, as provided in s. Ag 18.01, individual ingredients within that group shall not be listed on the label.
- (3) An ingredient used as a carrier for drugs, medications, vitamins and trace minerals in a premix shall not be listed on the label of a feed manufactured from the premix unless it makes up at least one per cent of the total ration.
- (4) No reference to quality or grade of an ingredient shall appear in the ingredient statement of a feed.

Ag 18.03 Ingredient disclosure. Feed manufacturers shall provide the department, on request, with a listing of specific individual ingredients used in any feed and labeled by means of a collective term.
