H 46.66 Admission of nonresidents. The camp is intended for the rehabilitation of Wisconsin residents, but since it is most economical to make the fullest possible use of the camp's facilities, the state health officer is authorized to admit nonresidents when there are sufficient vacant beds available. He shall arrange that payment of the cost of maintenance of any such patient is adequately guaranteed by some responsible person or agency as well as requiring such person or agency to arrange transportation of the patient to and from the camp. Any such patient may be discharged pursuant to rules H 46.63, 46.64 and 46.65, and shall be discharged at any time when the facilities of the camp may be needed for the care of Wisconsin residents. The state health officer shall see that there is at all times a sufficient reserve of vacant beds to insure the immediate admission, without waiting, of any Wisconsin resident eligible for the camp, and shall discharge nonresident patients when necessary to maintain such reserve of beds.
