
(4) Douglas county. (a) Douglas county hospital fields. Township 48 north, range 13 west, town of Packland.




(5) FOND DU LAC COUNTY. (a) Eldorado Marsh. Township 16 north, range 16 east, town of Eldorado.




(6) Green lake county. (a) ${\it Grand~River.}$ Township 15 north, range 11 east, town of Marquette.
