VE 4.01 Denial. An applicant who has not previously been licensed or certified in this state shall be denied a license or certificate if the applicant does not meet the standards or requirements for licensure or certification set forth in ch. 453, Stats., or rules promulgated thereunder.

VE 4.02 Notice and examination review. Upon denial of an application for a license or certificate, the board shall notify the applicant, stating the reason for denial, and that the applicant has the right to a hearing if written request is received by the board within 30 days after service of the notice of denial.
